- Updates scheduled MS Projects (percentage complete, delays, weather issues, etc.)
- Coordinates and communicates with subcontractors and site owner representatives daily
- Communicates with management, subcontractors, customers and vendors on a daily basis to ensure installation of the system per design drawings and specifications.
- Adherence to Site Specific Safety Plan which details the daily JHA (Job Hazard Analysis), daily inspections, and documentation of infractions.
- Conducts daily site safety checks and maintains Site Specific Safety Plan
- Keeps subcontractors and material flow per schedule.
- Communicates with utility companies to ensure interconnection requirements and testing for acceptance of the solar system.
- Follows Interconnection Agreement to ensure steps taken to achieve final interconnection acceptance
- Communicates with Authority Having Jurisdiction. Scheduling local inspections and acceptance.
- Obtains permits and schedules inspections based on local requirements.

- Minimum of 5 years of experience in leadership, construction or a related field.
- Proficiency in use of MS Excel, Outlook and other MS applications.
